EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT) COURSE *\$175.00 *NON-EMS PERSONNEL

This is the basic Emergency Medical Technician course which is a requirement in order to work with most rescue squads and EMS agencies. Upon successful completion, students will be administered a state exam through the North Carolina Office of EMS for certification as an EMT. An additional fee of \$10.00 is charged each student for supplies and each student must have an up to date manual. Students must score the 12th grade reading level on a reading comprehension exam. The reading comprehension exam is given on Wednesday nights at 7:45pm in Building 3 on RCC's campus in the Adult Education Program. The test is free. CPR HEARTSAVER \$65.00*

This is a basic life support training course for lay person. It is intended for the public, and basic skills are taught. CPR cards are an additional \$2.00 fee. For more information, or to schedule a class contact Flora Lowry-Williams at 910-272-3408.

CPR REFRESHER \$65.00*

This course is the Healthcare Provider CPR Refresher course. CPR cards are an additional \$2.00 fee. It will meet the requirements for day cares, nursing assistants, and any other agency that requires the American Heart Association Healthcare provider CPR. Written and performance testing is required. Pre-registration is required. For more information contact Flora Lowry-Williams at 910-272-3408.

NURSING ASSISTANT I \$175.00

This program is for listing on the state registry of the North Carolina Nurse Aide Registry. North Carolina registration is required for employment in a nursing home, long term care facility, hospital, or similar facility. The program consists of classroom work, practical exercises in skill areas and clinical work in a nursing home facility under the supervision of the instructor. Students must score at the 7th grade reading level on a reading comprehension exam. These tests are given Monday and Thursday evenings at 7:45pm and on Wednesday morning at 10:45am in Building 3 on RCC's campus by the Adult Basic Education Program. There is no charge to take the test. Students must have picture ID before they are allowed to test. If your test scores on the reading test is 7.0 or higher, you should bring the score to us in Building 17 and give us your address so that your name can be put on the list to receive the information on the next available Nursing Assistant classes. We will be teaching classes day and night on our main campus as well as at our new Com Tech Center in Pembroke. Additional fees are supply fee of \$5.00, malpractice insurance \$15.00, accidental insurance \$1.25 and \$120.00 fee for career readiness. A Career Readiness class will be held one week prior to the day classes starting and two weeks prior to the night classes starting. To have your name put on the list to receive information, please take the reading comprehension exam and provide us with a copy of your test scores. NURSING ASSISTANT REFRESHER

\$120.00

The Nursing Assistant Refresher Course is a 40 hour class designed for NAI's whose listing on the registry has expired. The course includes lecture, written exam, and competency evaluation. To be eligible for this course NAI's must have worked under the supervision of a RN during the last 2-4 years. A CPR Refresher book can be purchased at our bookstore for \$25.00. IF YOU DO NOT, YOU WILL NEED TO ORDER A DUPLICATE FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY OFFICE. KEEP IN MIND: IT WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY 2-3 WEEKS TO GET THE CARD ONCE YOU HAVE REQUESTED IT.

An additional fee of \$10.00 is charged each student for supplies and each student must have required manual and workbook. Students must have successfully completed a North Carolina EMT basic course.
