

ELIGIBILITY

 Declared major must be Associate in Arts (A.A.) or Associate in Science (A.S.)

 New students who wish to be considered for acceptance into RCC's Honors College must have earned a cumulative unweighted high school GPA of at least 3.25

• Current RCC students who wish to be considered for acceptance into RCC's Honors College must have earned a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 and have completed at least 12 hours in the A.A. or A.S. program
