TACTICAL TRACKER TRAINING SCHOOL

“LAND NAVIGATION/ORIENTEERING”

This course is a comprehensive Navigation Course designed to train Law Enforcement and other First Responder personnel how to navigate in various types of terrain in all weather conditions. This class teaches how to outfit and prepare for a multitude of situations. This map reading class course focuses on teaching students to read maps and interpret them. Concepts learned in this course include proximity, direction, region, density, latitude and longitude. Computer mapping and constructing maps will be discussed and students will be taught to use various direction finding equipment.
