## Supporting Materials (must include all)

1. **Letter of Recommendation.** Ask one of your teachers (existing RCC students: preferably a college instructor) to write a confidential letter of recommendation for you. This letter must be submitted on the form supplied by the Honors Program. You can download the recommendation form from our website ([www.robeson.edu/honors](http://www.robeson.edu/honors)). The completed recommendation should be sealed in an envelope, with the teacher's name signed across the sealed flap on the back of the envelope. Include that sealed letter with your application.
2. **Student Copy of Transcript.** Include a printed student (unofficial) copy of your most recent transcript. An official copy may be requested at a later date.
3. **Essay.** The following is the mission statement from the Honors website: "The mission of RCC's Honors Program is to offer academically motivated and talented students an intellectually challenging environment within a supportive and inspiring community. The Honors Program blends academic excellence and adventure, allowing students to complete advanced college transfer work while collaborating with fellow students and faculty, and serving the community." In a short essay of 250-500 typed words (1-2 pages double-spaced), explain how your academic experiences, your motivation, and your career goals align with the Honors Program mission statement.
4. **Creative Introduction.** Creatively show us who you are. You can do this either in a separate document or use a completely different medium of expression (if another medium, please include a brief written explanation or description).

If your application is considered for selection, you will receive an invitation to an on-campus interview. For this reason alone it is important that your contact information is up to date.
