Part V Provisional Acceptance

Particular consideration will be given to those applicants who have successfully completed the general /related education.
- 2) Applicants <u>must have a 2.8 or greater grade point average (GPA)</u> in program general education/related courses at the time of the application submission to Admissions in order to be considered for health science program admission.
- 3) Applicants provisionally accepted will be <u>required to submit a letter of intent and attend</u> a mandatory Meetn-Greet to secure their provisional acceptance.
