- Although <u>not</u> required for the major, points will be awarded for an earned grade of C or higher in college transfer mathematics (MAT 143, MAT 152 or MAT 171) and/or <u>NAS 102.</u> Although <u>not</u> required for the major, points will be awarded for an earned grade of B or higher in HSC 110 and MED 120. These courses <u>will not</u> be considered in the calculation of program GPA for admission.
- o Consideration will be given to applicants completing <u>A1030N -Associate in General Education</u> courses.

Part V Provisional Acceptance
