**Rules:**

- Teams are limited to five members each
- Cooking begins at 7:45 am---All chili must be cooked on-site
- **NO STORE-BOUGHT CHILI MIXES**
- Meat can be browned ahead of time
- Rice, beans, potatoes, chips, nachos or other ingredients may be pre-soaked, canned, cooked or packaged
- One table and paper products will be provided for each team
- All other equipment including cooking stoves, tents, etc. must be provided by the cooking team
- Electric service is not available
- Teams must prepare at least 10 gallons of chili to be used at the festival
- Rain or shine
- Decisions of the judges are final

**PLEASE NOTE:** All chili must be served in 2oz cups only! (Cups will be provided.)  
Signage must be provided and legible concerning the top 7 allergens: "May contain allergens: Milk, Eggs, Wheat, Peanuts, Tree Nuts, Soy, and Fish/Shellfish."

**Location:** Parking Lot on Corner of 3rd & Water Street (Across from Adelio's Restaurant)
