REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Preferred Qualifications</u>- Bachelor Degree in Culinary Arts or related field form a regionally accredited institution. Candidates with five or more years in the Culinary, Baking and Pastry or Hospitality field, two years teaching experience, and an ACF Certified Culinarian.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide effective instruction that demonstrates appropriate knowledge of his/her specialized field.
- > Demonstrate the effective use of pedagogical methods to meet various student-learning styles.
- Administer appropriate assessment and/or testing to measure student learning outcomes in all courses.
- Maintain appropriate classroom standards that include the effective management of students in the classroom and the management of classroom and lab facilities.
- Provide timely and accurate reports including 10% reports, grade reports, and other required reports related to instruction.
