IRS “Verification of Non-Filing Letter” Request Form

New federal regulations require some students/parents/spouses to submit proof that they did not file an IRS Tax Return for 2018.

Complete the following:

1. Request a “**Verification of Non-Filing Letter**” by accessing www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript.
This document must be dated on or after Oct. 1st, 2019
2. Request your letter(s) by one of the following methods:

What You Need

To register and use this service, you need:

- your [SSN](#), date of birth, filing status and mailing address from latest tax return,
- access to your email account,
- your personal account number from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and
- a mobile phone with your name on the account.

What You Get

- All [transcript types](#) are available online
- View, print or download your transcript
- Username and password to return later

What You Need

To use this service, you need your:

- [SSN](#) or [Individual Tax Identification Number \(ITIN\)](#),
- date of birth, and
- mailing address from your latest tax return

What You Get

- Return or Account [transcript types](#) delivered by mail
- Transcripts arrive in **5 to 10 calendar days** at the address we have on file for you

3. After you receive your Non-Filing letter from the IRS:

- A. Write the student name and student ID on the letter
- B. Keep a copy of the letter for your records
- C. Submit the Non-Filing letter to the Financial Aid Office
