**Overview:**

- Applicants **must have a 2.8 or higher program grade point average** (GPA) in the general education courses related to the major to be considered for provisional acceptance. Applicants **with a GPA less than 2.8 will not be considered for provisional acceptance**, but may be recommended for other Health Science programs.
- The GPA will be based upon grades earned in BIO 168, BIO 169, ENG 111, and PSY 150.
- Although **not** required for the major, points will be awarded for an earned grade of C or higher in college transfer mathematics (MAT 143, MAT 152 or MAT 171), HSC 110, MED 120, **NAS 102** and/or other general education courses related to the Associate Degree Nursing major. These courses **are not** considered in the calculation of Practical Nursing GPA for admission.
- Consideration will be given to applicants completing **A1030N -Associate in General Education** courses.

**Part IV References**

Each applicant must submit three professional references. Preference is given to references from academic, employment and/or professional affiliates. Only professional references will be awarded points. A maximum of two (2) points will be awarded for each reference for a total of six (6) points. Completed reference forms should be submitted (in sealed envelopes) with other admissions materials.

**Part V Provisional Acceptance**

- 1) A Point System will be used to rank applicants for provisional acceptance. Only applicants who have completed all the admissions requirements/criteria will be ranked for review. Particular consideration will be given to those applicants who have successfully completed the general /related education on the RCC campus.
- 2) **Applicants must have a 2.8 or greater grade point average (GPA) in program general education/related courses at the time of the application submission to Admissions in order to be considered for health science program admission.**
- 3) Applicants provisionally accepted will be **required to submit a letter of intent and attend** a mandatory Meet-n-Greet to secure their provisional acceptance.
  - *Applicants not accepted for program will be advised regarding alternate majors and/ or general education coursework.*

**Provisional Requirements**

Prior to receiving full acceptance and/or enrolling in the Nursing program, applicants provisionally accepted **MUST** complete and/or provide documentation of the following:

Requirement	Description
<b>Medical Screen</b>	A complete medical/ health screen provide by a licensed provider is required. The screen includes but not limited to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Two (2) separate PPDs: Proof of Negative Tuberculin (Tb) skin testing or follow-up chest X-ray within 3 months of enrollment.</li> <li>b. Immunizations                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <u>T-dap</u>, tetanus vaccines, Hepatitis B series, MMR, Rubella, Varicella series or positive titer (required)</li> <li>▪ Influenza, seasonal as required by clinical affiliate</li> <li>▪ COVID-19 – Fully vaccinated with the two dose or one dose regimen(s) as required by clinical affiliate</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
<b>Criminal Background Check and Drug Screen:</b>	Clinical agencies require a criminal background check and 12 panel urine drug-screen prior to clinical experiences. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. If results of a criminal background check and panel urine drug screen prevents a student from participating in a clinical experience at any agency, then the student will not be able to fulfill the clinical requirements for the program, and subsequently will not be allowed to enroll/ complete the Nursing program.</li> <li>b. This testing is scheduled by the College once Applicants have been provisionally accepted. However, fees associated with the criminal background check and drug screen will be the responsibility of the student.</li> </ol>
<b>Healthcare-Provider CPR</b>	Documentation of current/active American Heart Association - BLS Healthcare Providers CPR certification (including infant, child and adult certification).
<b>Nursing Orientation</b>	To be scheduled. Attendance required for full acceptance.
<b>Program Prerequisites</b>	Submit documentation of successfully completing the following courses with a “C” or higher: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ BIO 168 Human Anatomy &amp; Physiology I</li> <li>▪ Certification of completion of Nurse Aide I and Current listing on NC Registry without substantive findings</li> </ul>
