NOTE: Students must have a 3.0 or greater grade point average (GPA) in program general education/ related courses at the time of checklist submission to Admissions in order to be considered for health science program admission.

- For Sonography, the GPA will be based upon grades earned in PHY 110/110A, BIO 163 (or BIO 168/169), ENG 111, one Communications elective (COM 231 Public Speaking, ENG 112 or ENG 114), MAT 143 (or higher or MAT 140), MED 120, a Social/Behavioral Science elective, and the Humanities/Fine Arts elective.
- The Sonography Program Faculty will **not receive** student packets for review if the GPA is less than 3.0 in Sonography general education/related courses.
- Students may earn points for admission based upon final course grades in HSC 110; however, this course is **not** considered in the calculation of GPA for admission.
- Program applications are not carried over from one year to the next. They must be submitted each year to be considered.
- Robeson Community College does not create a waiting list for the Sonography Program.

Please place a check mark beside each item as they are completed. All items identified on the checklist must be completed prior to submitting checklist to the Admissions Office.

Part V Ultrasound Student Assessment (USA) Program

This is not a requirement for admission, however, applicants who are interested, may purchase and complete the Ultrasound Student Assessment (USA) Program for 2 additional points towards admission. Additional points may also be awarded depending on results of the USA Program.

Cost to student = \$85 (must include a proctor)

Instructions: Please access link. You are purchasing a testing slot for the USA Exam. Please allow up to 2 business days for your order to be processed. Once your order has been processed, a link to the proctor's testing calendar will be emailed to you. It is essential that you sign up using your school email address or include the name of your school in the comment section. If you do not do either, the link to the testing calendar will not be sent to you.

Once you receive the calendar link, you will be able to select a date for your exam. On the day of the exam, you will receive a unique meeting link via email that will allow you to connect with your assigned proctor. After you successfully join the meeting, the proctor will guide you through the next steps to ensure you are smoothly connected to the exam platform.

Part VI References

Each applicant must submit three references on forms provided by the Admissions Office. **The only references that will be awarded points are recent high school teachers, college faculty and an employer (applicant may submit references from 2 instructors and 1 employer or all 3 references**

may be from instructors). A maximum of 1 point will be awarded for each reference (total of 3 points). Completed rating forms should be submitted with all other admissions materials.

Part VII Provisional Acceptance

A point selection process will be used to rank applicants for provisional acceptance into the program. Only applicants who have completed all the admissions requirements/criteria will be ranked for review. Particular consideration will be given to those applicants who have successfully completed the general/related education courses for the program or appropriate high school courses. Completed application packets will be reviewed. Applicants should monitor e-mail for updates of application status sent by Sonography faculty. Applicants not provisionally accepted may schedule an appointment with a counselor to discuss other educational opportunities or continue with college course work and reapply the next year.

NOTE: Students must have a 3.0 or greater grade point average (GPA) in program general education/ related courses at the time of checklist submission to Admissions in order to be

considered for health science program admission. The Medical Sonography faculty will not review if the GPA is less than 3.0 in Sonography general education/related courses and pre-health courses.

Robeson Community College health science faculty will review the achievement potential of each applicant. During the candidate review process, faculty will examine previous academic records and pre-entrance examination scores to determine congruence with curriculum academic demands and program expectations.

Provisional Acceptance

Applicants who are chosen for the program are offered provisional acceptance based on fulfillment of all admission requirements/criteria by the deadline specified in the provisional acceptance letter. Applicants must return the letter of intent within 5 business days or the applicant will lose their seat and the next applicant on the list will be contacted.

Prior to receiving full acceptance and/or enrolling in the first sonography course, all Applicants Provisionally accepted **MUST** complete and/or provide documentation of the following:

1. Medical Review/Screen, which includes but not limited to:
 - a. (2) Separate PPDs: Proof of Negative Tuberculin (Tb) skin testing, negative QuantiFERON-TB blood test, or follow-up chest X-ray within 3 months of enrollment. ***Students should not receive the first PPD until they have been notified of provisional acceptance. 2nd PPD should be obtained after final acceptance & before Mandatory Orientation.***
 - b. Immunizations:
 - Tdap, tetanus vaccines, Hepatitis B series, MMR, Rubella, Varicella series or positive titer (required)
 - Influenza, (students who gain final acceptance are required to get the flu shot annually in September/October.)

- Covid-19 is not required at this time, however, students who gain final acceptance will be required to sign a Covid vaccination decision form.

2. **Criminal Background Check, Drug Screen and National Sex Offender Index:** Clinical agencies require a criminal background check, 12 panel urine drug screen and National Sex Offender Index prior to clinical experiences or rotations. This testing is scheduled by the College once students have been provisionally accepted.

NOTE:

(1) If results of a criminal background check, panel urine drug screen or sex offender index prevents a student from participating in a clinical rotation at any agency, then the student will not be able to fulfill the clinical requirements for the program, and subsequently will not be allowed to complete the Medical Sonography program.

(2) If results of a criminal background check prevent a student from being ARDMS registry eligible, then the student will not be allowed to complete the Medical Sonography program. *Students must be ARDMS registry-eligible to receive provisional acceptance into the program. It is the student's responsibility to determine whether they are ARDMS registry-eligible before receiving provisional acceptance. If at any time the student is unsure of eligibility, the student must provide documents proving ARDMS registry-eligibility by the Prep Course date. If ARDMS registry eligibility cannot

be proven by the Prep Course date, provisional acceptance will be terminated. Please refer to www.ardms.org for further information on the Compliance Policies.

(3) Fees associated with the medical review/screen, criminal background check, drug screen and sex offender index will be the responsibility of the student.

3. **Healthcare-Providers CPR:** Prospective students must submit documentation of current CPR certification (including infant, child and adult certification) from the American Heart Association BLS Healthcare Providers Course, after the student has received final acceptance and before Mandatory Orientation.
4. Successfully complete 2 job shadowing experiences (To be scheduled by Sonography faculty once students have been provisionally accepted.)
5. Participate in a 3-day Career Exploration into Medical Sonography course (Scheduled in late May/early June). Students provisionally accepted into the program will be notified by the Medical Sonography Program Director of the specific dates and times of the course. Attendance for the entire face-to-face course is required for consideration for final acceptance into the program. This course will serve to introduce potential students to the terminology, equipment and physics related to Medical Sonography. Students will be awarded points and considered for final acceptance based on their performance on written assessments and skills checkoffs completed during the course.
6. Attend a **Mandatory Sonography Orientation** (Scheduled in mid-July, for students receiving final acceptance)
7. **Program Prerequisites:** Applicants admitted to the program must submit prior to enrollment into the program documentation of successfully completing the following courses with a "C" or higher:
 - BIO 163 Basic Anatomy & Physiology (or BIO 168 and 169)
 - PHY 110/110A (Conceptual Physics/ Conceptual Physics Lab)
 - MED 120 Survey of Medical Terminology

8. Provisionally accepted students previously enrolled in any other sonography program must submit a letter from the program director. Failure to submit this letter will result in cancellation of the student's application.
9. Provide evidence of individual medical insurance coverage.

Health Science Alternatives

If I am **not** accepted in my program of choice, I request that my application packet be forwarded to the program(s) marked below. If more than one program is selected, please rank them beginning with “1” being the first choice, “2” second choice. Please pick a maximum of 2 programs only. **Consider alternative program requirements and application deadlines to ensure you are choosing programs for which you qualify (Example: If you are completing your application for the Radiography Program, and indicating Medical Sonography as your first alternative program, you must have credit for PHY 110 and 110A to meet their application requirements.)**

- _____ Respiratory Therapy
Requirements: Minimum 2.5 GPA in program Prerequisites and Corequisites. Prerequisites: BIO 168, BIO 169, CHM 131 & 131A or CHM 151, MAT 110.
- _____ Surgical Technology
Requirements: Minimum 2.8 GPA in program Prerequisites and Corequisites. Prerequisites: BIO 168, BIO 169.
