LEVEL I

The student will also learn the skills necessary to gather forensic evidence and intelligence. This course is a prerequisite to Tactical Mantracking Level 2.

Students need to bring:

<u>Day 1:</u>

Attire: Professional or Contractor Casual or BDU type. Foot ware should be a tactical or aggressive, sport tread pattern Note book and pen or pencil, Compass (every day), pocket note pad and pencil, tape measure,

Day 2-5:

- Attire: BDU or type clothing. LBE, ruck sack or pack, hydration system, head gear preferably boonie style, eye protection, rain gear, tactical gloves optional but recommended, any additional duty gear used in actual operations.
- Kit: Compass, retractable tape measure, small ruler (6-8"), pocket note pad and pencil, standard note pad and pen for classroom, eye protection, lunch and energy snacks such as trail mix, daily. (all lunches after day 1 will be held in the field) HYDRATION and electrolytes.

Optional Equipment: Map case, Binoculars, hand held or wrist GPS, duty weapons or, training weapons,

Remember, train as you fight. If you'll use it in the real world, bring it to training.
